
Petroleum Minister discusses with the Chairman of (IPR) the outstanding results achieved in its concession areas and the new geological layers

\$ 110 million to drill new wells in El Alamein and Fayoum

Mahmoud, Chairman of the company, reviewed its efforts in the areas of Abu Rawash, Beni Suef and Fayoum, and that it plans to invest \$ 110 million to drill new wells in El Alamein and Fayoum, which are making progress, and reviewed the projects of the zero carbon initiative and the use of gas as an alternative to diesel and diesel in electricity generators, which contributes to reducing and improving production costs, stressing its commitment to increasing its investments in Egypt in resources and technologies and continuing production, especially in the El Alamein area, in light of its promising petroleum potential.
